## ENTRY TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- The 2020 Elite Sale is open to:
  - White Suffolk studs who are members of the Australian White Suffolk Association Incorporated;
  - Suffolk studs who are members of the Suffolk Sheep Society of Australia (ASSBA); and
  - Suffolk studs who are members of the Australian Suffolk Association (ASA).
- A membership fee of \$110 (GST inclusive) per vendor must be paid to the Elite Show & Sale Committee.
- An entry fee of **\$77.00 per ram** and **\$55.00 per ewe** (GST inclusive) is applicable and payable to the Elite Show & Sale Committee.
- A **maximum of 3 rams and 3 ewes per stud** to be offered.
- Vendors are reminded of their responsibility to ensure that all rams and ewes offered for sale are structurally and physically sound and meet individual breed standards.
- All entries **must** be accompanied by a National Vendor Declaration (NVD) and National Sheep Health Statement.
- The Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry. The Committee reserves the right to restrict entries if deemed necessary.
- All animals entered in the Sale must be the bona-fide property of the Vendor and must be eligible for registration with the relevant breed society.
- All animals must be from an Ovine Brucellosis accredited flock and are to be either in the MAP or Faecal or Abattoir tested or Vaccinated to be accepted in the Sale. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry that does not meet the biosecurity or health standards of the Sale. A copy of the Vendor's Ovine Brucellosis Accreditation Certificate must accompany sale entries. It is highly recommended that Sale sheep are Hypotrochosis tested.
- Entries must be submitted on the required entry form (either hardcopy or online) and the Vendor declaration must be completed by the Vendor or his/her authorised agent. The Vendor submitting the entry is responsible that the statements on the entry form are true and correct. Entries shall be made and accepted subject to the rules and regulation of the Committee.
- Pedigree data for all sale animals must be provided with entry. At a minimum the Sire, Dam and Sire of Dam must be included. For online entry, vendors will have the opportunity to upload a PDF pedigree for each animal if preferred or provide a link to the animal on LAMBPLAN.
- The Committee shall have the right to determine the order, manner, and management of the sale.
- The Committee in no way warrants the condition, quality or performance of any rams or ewes offered for sale, and the vendor agrees to indemnify the Elite Committee, Australian White Suffolk Association Inc, Suffolk Sheep Society of Australia (ASSBA) and the Australia Suffolk Association (ASA) and keep them indemnified in respect of any claim that may be made by any person in respect of condition, quality, performance or state of health of the animals entered in the sale.
- All lots sold will be subject to 7% agent commission with an additional 2% commission payable to the Elite Committee.
- A refund of entry fees will be allowed for any withdrawal of entries prior to the closing date for entries (31 July). Refund of entry fees for withdrawal of entries after the closing date can submitted in writing to the Secretary and will be made at the discretion of the Committee. The Committee's decision will be final.
- Closing date for entries is strictly 9:00am, Friday 31<sup>st</sup> July 2020.** No late entries will be permitted.

## Photographs/Videos and animal information requirements:

- **Photographs and/or a video** of each entry is to be supplied for each animal entered by **31<sup>st</sup> July**. All photos and videos will be published on the AuctionsPlus website, the PDF sale catalogue and used in promotion of the sale on social media and the AWSA website.

Photograph requirements: A minimum of 5 photographs are requested per entry (front, back, both sides and mouth).

Video requirements: Videos should be no longer than 1-minute per entry and must not include subtitles, background music or commentary. All videos will be uploaded to the Elite Show & Sale youtube channel and linked to the AuctionsPlus catalogue.

Submission of photographs and videos: Photographs and videos can be submitted by email to [eliteshowsale@gmail.com](mailto:eliteshowsale@gmail.com). Alternatively, they can be forwarded through Facebook Messenger to the Elite Show & Sale Facebook page. Please make sure photo and videos are not resized when sending to ensure they remain at a high standard/quality. - **Vendor comments / description** for each lot can be provided with each entry. A maximum of 50 words per lot is allowed. Information such as animal weight and date weighed, or raw scan data with date of scan can be included in the description.
- **Pedigrees** – Vendors are welcome to supply a full pedigree as a PDF for inclusion in the online sale catalogue. Alternatively, a link to the pedigree and ASBV's of each sale entry on Sheep Genetics can be provided and included in the catalogue.
- Changes or additions to any lot information can be made up until the closing date of entries (31<sup>st</sup> July) in writing to [eliteshowsale@gmail.com](mailto:eliteshowsale@gmail.com).

## AUCTION TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. The Sale will be conducted as a simultaneous sale (Helmsman style) on AuctionsPlus under the AuctionsPlus User Agreement and Sale Terms. These can be referenced at <https://auctionsplus.com.au/auctionsplus/operating-conditions>
2. The minimum Reserve Price for all rams offered in the sale will be set at **\$2,500**. The minimum Reserve Price for all ewes offered in the sale will be set at **\$600**. Vendors will have the opportunity to set their own individual higher reserve per lot if they wish.
3. Minimum bidding increments for rams and ewes will be set by the Elite Committee, however vendors will also have the opportunity to increase increase the bidding increment on their individual lot(s) prior to sale.
4. Buyers are encouraged to be aware of the restrictions relevant to their location in regards to OJD management and sheep movements. It is the buyer's responsibility to ensure they can take delivery.
5. All new registered AuctionsPlus buyers are required to complete Buyer Induction Training prior to bidding. AuctionsPlus recommends that all intending bidders complete their registration and training 24 hours prior to the Auction. 6. Transportation and the cost of transportation of any lot sold is to be agreed between the purchaser and vendor, with liability to pass to the purchaser at the conclusion of the sale. The Elite Committee recommends that purchases insure their purchases.
7. The agents will be working in conjunction and therefore there is no need to select a duty agent for individual lots.



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
