How to Guide: Creating an account

A guide creating an account for the search site

For: ram breeders, ram buyers and service providers

You can create and register an account to use the site. The best thing is that anyone can create an account and it's FREE!

When you are logged in you can:

- save searches
- customise and save your ASBV columns
- export results
- access your flocks information and create catalogues (SG members only)

We have different ways to create accounts for

- a) Existing Sheep Genetics Clients and Service Providers
- b) Ram buyers and non-members

Key Steps to creating an account:

a) Sheep Genetics Clients and Service Providers


1. Your account has already been created. You will have received an email asking you to register your email address
2. Follow the prompts from the email to finish setting up your email address

If you did not receive an email:

3. Create an account using the instructions below for ram buyers and non-members
4. Email Sheep Genetics on info@sheepgenetics.org.au and provide the following information:
 - Your name and the email address you have registered
 - The flocks you wish to have access to
 - Permission from the flock (if applicable)
5. You will be granted access within 24hours (Mon-Fri excl. Public Holidays)


b) Ram buyers and non-members

1. You can create an account by clicking on “Register” on the new search site
